Defines FASD and summarizes the Surgeon General's Advisory on Alcohol Use in Pregnancy. Emphasizes the importance of early screening of women, especially pregnant women.

Alerts pregnant women to the dangers of drinking alcohol while pregnant. Details physiological effects alcohol has on a fetus at various stages of gestation. Defines Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorders (FASD).
